


WORKING IN FRANCE: WHAT ARE MY RIGHTS?


WHATEVER YOUR SITUATION IS, YOU HAVE

RIGHTS IN FRANCE

You cannot work **more** than 10 hours per day



You cannot work more than 6 days per week



You should be **paid every month**





Even if you are undocumented, you can:

- Seek care in a hospital
- File a complaint with the police
- Contact the Labour Inspectorate



Beware! An employment contract cannot be bought nor sold.



ADVICES

- Make sure you have access to decent working and living conditions (meals, shower, hot water, heat, etc.) Do not hesitate to ask specific questions
- If provided, the accommodation must be decent.
- Keep your identification documents with you and make copies
- Open a bank account in your own name
