

# WORKING IN FRANCE: WHAT ARE MY RIGHTS?




**WHATEVER YOUR SITUATION IS, YOU HAVE RIGHTS IN FRANCE**


You should be **paid every month**



You cannot work **more than 6 days per week**



You cannot work **more than 10 hours per day**



**A written contract protects you !**

**Beware ! An employment contract cannot be bought nor sold.**

The minimum monthly salary\* is approximately **1443€ net/month for working 35 hours per week** (€12.02 per hour)





*\* In 2026. It gets higher every year.

**Aside from your accommodation\*, your employer cannot withhold part of your salary for a service provided or a fault.**
